

Special Called Council Meeting

Tuesday, January 21, 2025

A Special Called Town Council meeting was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on January 21, 2025, at 1:30 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Chris King, Beau Proffitt, and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on January 20, 2025.

Call to Order & Invocation

Mayor Atkinson asked Councilmember King to give the invocation, he then asked Councilmember Shaw to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Beau Proffitt made a motion to accept the second reading of the FY24 Audit as presented at our last meeting by Matt Phillips. Chris King made the second and the vote to adopt the FY24 Audit was unanimously passed.

Beau Proffitt made a motion to accept the second reading of the annual update to the Six Mile Business License Ordinance. Chris King made the second and after some discussion the Business License Ordinance was renewed with the following minor updates primarily to promote regional uniformity:

- Lower the income threshold for the base rate to \$0-\$2000

- Increase the rate for Class 8 businesses to \$1.50 for each additional \$1000 of income above the base threshold

- Add 722410 NAICS code


- Introduce a dual penalty structure as follows:

 - A \$25 administrative processing late fee


 - A penalty of 15% for the first delinquent month and 5% for each subsequent month
