

Special Called Council Meeting

Thursday, March 13, 2025

A special-called Town Council/Budget meeting was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on March 13, 2025, at 6:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Mark Beckman, Chris King, and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on March 12, 2025.

Call to Order & Invocation

Mayor Atkinson asked Mark Beckman to give the Invocation, he then asked Chris King to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Atkinson asked Katie Rampey to present her tentative budgets for the events coming up in the FY26 budget year. She first asked Council about increasing her pay for Events Coordinator to \$12,000 per year and was told that would be handled in Executive Session. She proceeded to go through each event with her estimations of revenue and expenses. Council thanked her for her input.

Chris King then made a motion at 6:26 P.M., to go into Executive Session for the purpose of Legal, Contractual, and/or Personnel Matters per SC State Code Section 30-4-70(a). Executive Session pursuant to S.C. Code Section 30-4-70(a)(2) which may include discussions related to proposed potential contractual arrangements, legal matters, and various personnel matters. Mark Beckman made the second. The vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.

Mayor Atkinson called the meeting back to order at 7:43P.M. and asked if there were any motions to come from Executive Session and was told there were none.

Mark Beckman made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Chris King made the second and the vote to adjourn the meeting was unanimous.
