

Regular Council Meeting

Tuesday, April 8, 2025

The Regular Town Council meeting was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on April 8, 2025, at 7:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Mark Beckman, Chis King and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on April 7, 2025.

Call to Order & Invocation

Mayor Atkinson asked Chris King to give the invocation. He then asked for a moment of silence in remembrance of Milton “Sac” Alexander and “Dude” McAbee, two Six Mile natives that recently passed away. Mark Beckman lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Session/Guests:

Mayor Atkinson asked Esther Wagner of Palmetto Pride to speak about the issue of litter and her organization.

The Mayor then asked if anyone would like to speak in public session and Casey Durbin of Mt. Olivet Road spoke about the benefits of having a pump track at the Downtown Community Park.

Consent Agenda

The minutes for March 4, 13 and 25, 2025, were approved.

Committee Reporting

Administration/Finance/Greenspace: Mayor Atkinson mentioned that the main thing that stands out is the maintenance and capital accounts due to the infrastructure expenses earlier in the fiscal year.

Public Health and Infrastructure: Chairman King had nothing to report.

Recreation: Chairman Proffitt was absent.

IT/Safety: Chairperson Beckman gave the statistics report from the County and reported that the safety manual is still in progress.

HR/Volunteers: Chairperson Shaw reported that she has almost completed a revision draft of the Employee Handbook. She is planning a cleanup day on April 26 from 8 until 12 pm. Volunteers will register that morning and pick up supplies. Afterwards they will receive a gift certificate for a free scoop of ice cream at The Scoop for their participation.

Judy Shaw made a motion to affirm April 25th as Arbor Day, Chris King made the second and the vote to affirm this Proclamation was unanimous.

Judy Shaw made a motion to affirm April 22nd as Earth Day, Mark Beckman made the second and the vote to affirm this Proclamation was unanimous.

Chris King made a motion to go into Executive Session for the purpose of Legal, Contractual, and/or Personnel Matters per SC State Code Section 30-4-70(a). Executive Session pursuant to S.C. Code Section 30-4-70(a)(2) which may include discussions related to proposed potential contractual arrangements, and various personnel matters at 7:37 pm. Judy Shaw made the second. The vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.

Regular Council Meeting


Tuesday, April 8, 2025
