- 9) Consider a motion, as has been the longstanding practice of Six Mile Town Council, that our town policy is that invocations be only given by an elected public council member to the deliberative public body. These invocations made at Council meetings are to be addressed to and made for the benefit of Council, rather than to others who may be present. The person offering the invocation may do so according to the dictates of that person's faith, belief, and conscience but may not: Proselytize; advance any one faith or belief; disparage any other faith or belief; nor coerce participation by any person present. All participation in invocations is strictly voluntary.
- 10) Consider a motion to accept a Proclamation declaring the week of March 9th as Emergency Services/Emergency Management/Six Mile Fire Department week in the Town of Six Mile.
- 11) Consider a motion affirming Governor McMaster's designation of March 2 through March 8 as South Carolina Severe Flood and Safety Week. The goal is to raise awareness about the significant hazards from severe storms, tornadoes, and flash floods while encouraging residents to take proper safety measures and update their emergency preparedness kits. On March 13, 1929, nine members of one family were killed and others were injured when a tornado hit downtown Six Mile.
