

Special Called Council Meeting

Thursday, May 15, 2025

A special-called Town Council meeting was held by the Six Mile Town Council at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on May 15, 2025, at 2:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson: Presiding; Council: Mark Beckman, Beau Proffitt and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on May 14, 2025.

Call to Order & Invocation

Mayor Atkinson asked Beau Proffitt to give the Invocation. He then asked Mark Beckman to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Guest Informational/Invited Speaker

Mayor Atkinson asked Stan Butler to give an update for the Recreation Department. He said that a very successful Spring Season is coming to an end and Fall Registration will start June 9th.

Beau Proffitt made a motion to approve the first reading of the FY26 Budget in the amount of \$486,213 and the FY26 Non-Reverting Recreation Budget in the amount of \$90,600. Mark Beckman made the second and the vote to pass the first reading of the FY26 Budget was passed.

Beau Proffitt then made a motion to go into Executive Session for the purpose of Legal, Contractual, and/or Personnel Matters per SC State Code Section 30-4-70(a). Executive Session pursuant to S.C. Code Section 30-4-70(a)(2) which may include discussions related to proposed potential contractual arrangements, legal matters, and various personnel matters. Mark Beckman made the second. The vote to go into Executive Session was unanimous.

Mayor Atkinson called the meeting back to order at 3:25 P.M. and asked if there were any motions to come from Executive Session and there were none.

Beau Proffitt made a motion to adjourn the meeting; Mark Beckman made the second and the vote to adjourn the meeting was unanimous.
