

Special Called Council Meeting

Tuesday, June 16, 2026

A Special Called Town Council meeting of the Six Mile Town Council was held at Town Hall (106 South Main Street, Six Mile, S.C.) on June 16, 2026, at 7:00 PM. Members in attendance were Mayor James Atkinson, presiding, and Council Members Mark Beckman, Chris King, Beau Proffitt, and Judy Shaw. The agenda was emailed to the Pickens County Courier and the Journal on June 11, 2026.

Call to Order & Invocation & Pledge

Mayor Atkinson called the meeting to order. The invocation was given by Beau Proffitt, and Chris King led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Agenda Items

Mayor Atkinson discussed the recently cleaned condition of the Downtown Community Park and stated that the Annex only requires completion of handicap access.

Executive Session

At 7:02 PM, Chris King made a motion to enter Executive Session pursuant to S.C. Code Sec. 30-4-70(a)(2) for the purpose of discussion of negotiations incident to proposed contractual arrangements. These matters concern a potential contract for services at the Downtown Community Park and a potential contract for services to be provided to the Town at Town Hall during FY2026-27. Beau Proffitt made the second and the vote passed unanimously.

At 8:12 PM, Mayor Atkinson called the meeting back to order and asked whether there were any motions resulting from Executive Session.

- Chris King made a motion for the Town of Six Mile to offer Mr. Tom Brooks a part-time administrative services position, pending satisfactory background checks. These services would be provided during an initial ninety (90) day period at an annual rate of \$55,000, with participation in the State Retirement System. The Town's attorney was instructed to prepare a written contract for review by Mr. Brooks and return it to Council for final approval and execution. Judy Shaw seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.
- Beau Proffitt made a motion to accept the resignation of Stanley Butler, effective July 14, 2026. Judy Shaw seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.
- Beau Proffitt made a motion to hire Randy Robinson for maintenance services, effective July 1, 2026, for a contracted amount of \$24,000, to be split evenly between NR Recreation funds and General funds. Judy Shaw seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

Adjournment

Chris King made a motion to adjourn. Judy Shaw seconded the motion, and the meeting adjourned at 8:15 PM.
