

Temporary Use of Temporary A-Frame Signs, Fluttering Ribbons and Banners

Temporary A-Frame Signs, fluttering ribbons and banners may be used by a newly established business, or civic organization (e.g. church, lodge) for a maximum of up to forty-five (45) days during the first year that the business, institution, or civic organization is located at a site. A sign permit must be purchased for temporary signage. The temporary signage shall be limited to only forty-five (45) days prior to the date of any referenced events, shall be no more than ten (10) signs in total. may not be placed on utility poles, trees, or public rights of way and must have property owners' permission for placement. No temporary sign or temporary sign location may interfere with the safe operation of vehicular traffic or with pedestrian traffic. Utilization of fluttering ribbons or a banner under this provision shall require the issuance of a Special Event Sign Permit (as defined in the permit) by the Town of Six Mile. The Town Council of Six Mile is hereby authorized to establish a fee for the Special Event Sign Permit. Temporary signs must be removed within seven (7) days after any referenced event. The size of any such sign shall not be in excess of six (6) square feet and not in excess of (3) feet in width.
